BEACHWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed Bond Issue and Tax Levy

Shall the Beachwood City School District be authorized to do the following:

(1.) Issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities, including a consolidated elementary school, and clearing and improving their sites in the principal amount of \$39,000,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 35 years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over the bond repayment period 2.8 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 28 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

(2.) Levy an additional property tax to pay current operating expenses at a rate not exceeding 5.9 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 59 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, for a continuing period of time?

BRECKSVILLE/BROADVIEW HTS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed Bond Issue

Shall bonds be issued by the Brecksville-Broadview Heights City School District for the purpose of constructing, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving a new elementary school, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving existing School District buildings and facilities and acquiring, clearing, improving and equipping real estate for School District buildings and facilities in the principal amount of \$44,500,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 35 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 2.2 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 22 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

BROOKLYN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Brooklyn City School District for the purpose of avoiding an operating deficit in the sum of \$2,254,000 and levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average 7.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, for a period of five years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019?

EUCLID CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Euclid City School District for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the School District in the sum of \$5,600,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county fiscal officer to average 10.1 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$1.01 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of 10 years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019?

PARMA CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

Shall a levy be imposed by the Parma City School District for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of the school district in the sum of \$14,724,327 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average 7.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 74 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of ten years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar 2019?

SHAKER HEIGHTS LIBRARY DISTRICT
Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

An additional tax for the benefit of the Shaker Heights Public Library for the purpose of current expenses of the Shaker Heights Public Library at a rate not exceeding 1.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 19 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2018, for first collection in 2019.

SOLON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)

Shall the Solon City School District be authorized to levy taxes for current expenses, the aggregate rate of which may increase in one increment of not more than 6.9 mills for each dollar of valuation, from an original rate of 1.6 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to 16 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to a maximum rate of 8.5 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to 85 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation? The original tax is first proposed to be levied in 2018 and the incremental tax in 2019. The aggregate rate of tax so authorized will be in effect for a continuing period of time.

WESTLAKE LIBRARY DISTRICT
Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Porter Public Library for the purpose of current expenses at a rate of 2.8 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 28 cents for each one hundred dollars in valuation, for five years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Cuyahoga County for the purpose of supplementing the general fund appropriations for health and human or social services at a rate not exceeding 3.9 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 39 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for two years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.

Proposed Bond Issue

Shall bonds be issued by the City of North Olmsted for the purpose of improving the City's park and recreational facilities by constructing, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving facilities for aquatics, basketball, volleyball, ice skating, fitness, indoor and outdoor walking and gymnastics, ball fields, public spaces, locker rooms and spaces for related and supporting activities at the Recreation Center complex; improving North Olmsted Community Park by constructing, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving a new football and soccer field, a band shell and performance stage, an all-purpose trail, playgrounds, bocce courts, parking areas and related supporting facilities and improving existing ball fields, restrooms and other facilities; and improving Barton and Bradley park by improving existing facilities and providing supporting site, street and sidewalk improvements, in each case together with the necessary appurtenances and work incidental thereto, in the principal amount of \$44,800,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 24 years, and an annual levy of property taxes to be made outside the 11.1 mill charter tax limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over repayment period of the bond issue 3.6 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 36 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?
